**Music of the week:** As the weather changes, and we enter a new season, the children have listened to 'Autumn' from Vivaldi's 'The Four Seasons'.

**It's Good To Grow with Morrisons:** This is a schools collector scheme where anyone who shops at Morrisons can collect 'Grow Tokens' and donate them to us, to be redeemed against FREE gardening equipment. But time is running out – the scheme ends on 24<sup>th</sup> October!

## How does it work?

- 1. Scan your physical or digital MyMorrisons card every time you shop, or link it to your account online or via the app.
- 2. Collect 1 'Grow Token' for every £10 spent in store or online.
- 3. On your MyMorrisons account, go to the 'It's Good to Grow' section and select your chosen school and donate your Grow Tokens.
- 4. After the collection period, schools can redeem their Grow Tokens against gardening equipment to get kids growing!

It would be great to have anyone who shops at Morrisons donate their 'Good to Grow' tokens to us!
