## COVID update:

Please keep an eye out for a reminder letter – we need to ensure that all members of our school community abide by the expectations in order to keep us all safe. This will be sent out later this weekend.

As we have to keep all rooms really well ventilated in line with guidance, children are becoming chilly during lessons. Please can you make sure that all children come to school with a **NAMED** cardigan/jumper and it might be a good idea to have a **NAMED** plain black fleece/hoody that can be worn over the top. We take children out to play even in drizzle and light rain, so please send your child in with a **NAMED** coat.

## General reminders and information:

Walk to School Week/ Clean Air Day: There is a focus next week on keeping healthy and reducing pollution. Can you leave the car at home, or park a little further away from school to 'do your bit' for the environment? On Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> there will be campaigners outside school highlighting choices that have a positive impact on our environment.

**PTA Meetings:** Our PTA have some great events planned – for the whole family! They would like to introduce the new committee and share their fundraising plans with all parents. There will be two opportunities to join a virtual PTA meeting. Hopefully by offering different time slots we will be able to attract a wide number of parents. We are especially keen to get our new families actively involved. The first PTA meeting is on **Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October will be at 7pm** and then the second meeting will be on **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October at 2pm**. The agenda for both meetings will be the same. A joining code will be sent out on Monday.

Please look out for the letter about a PTA Virtual Halloween Balloon Race. A virtual race works in the same way as a helium balloon race, but they fly around their own webpage rather than in the atmosphere; much more environmentally friendly!

Each Halloween themed balloon costs £2 and we would love you to buy as many as possible.



On Friday 23rd October 2020, all the balloons will be 'released' and left to fly around the virtual spooky island. Every hour each balloon travels between 1km and 20km. At the end of the race on Friday 30th October 2020 the 3 balloons which have travelled the farthest will win Amazon vouchers.

To buy your balloons please make payment direct to the PTA Balloon Race account on the School Gateway. If you are able to buy more than one balloon, all you need do is to go back into the system and pay again. We will contact you with the nickname of your balloon so you can track its progress on the webpage. All monies must be received by **Friday**, **16th October 2020** for inclusion in the race.

**Flu vaccinations:** Intra-Health have had to rearrange their visit to administer the nasal flu vaccination for all our pupils. If you have still not returned the forms, please contact the office who have spares. Given the current COVID situation, having this nasal flu spray is crucially important.

**Bag2School:** As a way to raise money for our PTA (Parent Teacher Association) we collect unwanted clothes, towels, bedding. These can be brought to school over an extended period – we will accept bags of clothing on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> October, Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> October**. You can bring unwanted items in bin bags. The company Bag2School weighs the bags and then pays us per kilo. This is an excellent and easy way to raise funds. So start collecting old and unwanted clothing, towels and bedding.

**Secondary School Applications:** All our Year 6 pupils need to have made a decision about their Secondary School by **31**<sup>st</sup> **October**. Applications are completed via an online form on the MCC website. If parents want advice or guidance on this process, do please email me. I would urge Year 5 families to start visiting secondary schools this term too.
